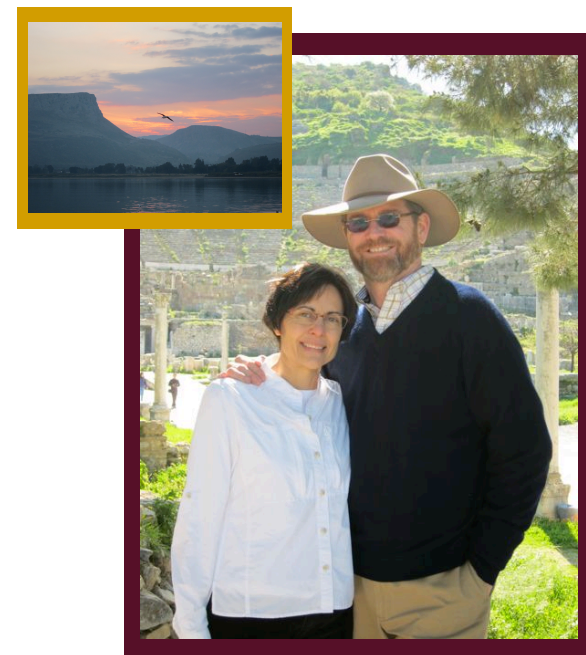

THU, JAN 5

We depart for Tel Aviv on board our overnight flight.

FRI, JAN 6

Arrive at **Tel Aviv's Ben Gurion Airport** and meet our guides and drive to Caesarea Maritima for Mass, dinner and overnight at our hotel. **D**

SAT, JAN 7

We begin our tour at **Caesarea Maritima**, where Jeff will use the acoustics of the Roman theatre as a perfect setting for our tour orientation and teaching and then it's on to **Mount Carmel**.

Mass will be celebrated where the prophet Elijah slew the false prophets of Ba'al followed by a visit to **Megiddo**, the ancient chariot city overlooking the valley of **Armageddon**. Next on to the **Sea of Galilee**.

SUN, JAN 8

A morning drive to **Cana** will allow the opportunity to renew wedding vows. We will celebrate Mass at **The Church of the Annunciation** in **Nazareth**, and visit **Kfar Kedem**, a model of life in the time of Jesus. Returning to the Sea of Galilee, we will visit the Ancient Boat at **Kibbutz Nof Ginosar**. In the evening, confessions with our priests on the shore of the sea.

MON, JAN 9

Today we travel by boat on the Sea of Galilee to **Capernaum** and have Mass at a church which stands over St. Peter's house. Next on to the **Mount of the Beatitudes** and then north through the **Hula Valley** to **Caesarea Philippi** and the ancient site of **Tel Dan**.

TUE, JAN 10

We will have mass at **St. Peter Primacy** along the Sea of Galilee, followed by a visit to **Tabgha**, site of the multiplication of the loaves and fishes. Then we depart the Galilee stopping at the **Mt. of Transfiguration**, then visiting the archeological site of **Bet She'an** before passing by the oasis of **Jericho** and driving along the **Dead Sea** coast. **Le Meridien Hotel. B D**

WED, JAN 11

Today we visit **Masada**, the wilderness fortress built by Herod the Great, and then **En Gedi**, where David hid from King Saul. We will have mass and renew our baptismal vows near the **Jordan River**. Next we visit **Qumran** to tour the site where the **Dead Sea Scrolls** were found.

Then it's up to **Jerusalem. Olive Tree Hotel, Jerusalem. B D**

THU, JAN 12

The day begins on the **Mount of Olives** then to the **Church of the Ascension**, the **Garden of Gethsemane** and the **Church of All Nations** for Mass. After crossing the **Kidron Valley**, we drive up to **Mt. Zion** and visit the **Upper Room**, finishing the day at the **Israel Museum**, **Shrine of the Book**, and a **Model of 1st Century Jerusalem**.

FRI, JAN 13

Today we go to Bethlehem, the birthplace of Jesus, passing **Rachel's Tomb** to visit the **Church of the Nativity**, and the **Shepherd's Fields**. Mass will be at the **Church of St. Catherine's**. We will stop to shop at an olive wood store, a Christian establishment.

SAT, JAN 14

Perhaps the most meaningful day of the tour, we'll walk the 14 stations of the **Via Dolorosa**, Christ's route to the Cross, ending at the **Church of the Holy Sepulcher** for Mass. In the afternoon we will go to **Ein Kerem**, birthplace of John the Baptist, to visit the **Church of the Visitation**.

Free day in Jerusalem to rest up, walk the Old City, or tour the Holocaust Museum **Yad Vashem**.
